TRANSFER OF BENEFITS UNDER THE PROVISION OF SECTION 13
OF FEBF&GI ACT, 1969 TO OTHER FAMILY MEMBER

In supersession of this office circular of even no. dated 09.08.2023, and in pursuance of Law Division advice vide O.M. F.No167/2023-Law-I dated 05.07.2023 conveyed vide Establishment Division U.O No.5-11/2016-Admn-III dated 07.07.2023 on the subject, it has been decided that the share of a widow or children, who after some time become ineligible, will be transferred or divided equally to the other surviving widows or children, as the case may be, in terms of Sub-section 3 of Section 13 of FEBF &GI Act, 1969 (II of 1969). Provided that, if the deceased employee has no spouse or the spouse dies, other members of his family shall be entitled to receive benevolent grant from benevolent fund as prescribed for a period of fifteen(15) years. The period shall be reckoned from the date from which the deceased employee or, as the case may be, the spouse becomes eligible for such grant.
